⇒ The Village of South Holland recently hosted the **Junior League State Championship Series** at Gouwens Park. Guests from all over the state of Illinois raved about our park and hospitality. Many expressed their desire to make South Holland the host community for future tournaments.

Other Notables

- ◆ Pastor Shawn Dalcour from New Jerusalem Kingdom Ministries opened the meeting with prayer.
- ◆ The board approved an ordinance adopting the 2009 ICC building permit fee schedule.
- ◆ The board approved an ordinance requiring the inspection of billboard signs located in South Holland along the expressway.
- ◆ The board approved financial registers 660 and 661, in the total amount of \$966,309.19, covering day-to-day operations, vendor payments and salaries.
- ◆ The Community Center pool and spa will be closed Tuesday, August 25 - Monday, September 7 for upgrades to the main drains, as required by a new federal law, "Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act".
