The board approved an ordinance modifying parking regulations. The modified ordinance restricts parking near mailboxes between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The board approved a resolution appointing Deputy Police Chief Robert Stegenga to the E-Com Operating Committee for 2010.

The board approved a resolution appointing Rich Zimmerman to the E-Com Executive Board for 2010.

The board approved the employment contract for the village administrator.
