## Finance

Trustee Sullivan moved for the approval of finance register #697 in the amount of \$1,143,490.83. The board approved this register, which covers day-to-day operations, vendor payments and salaries.

## Other Notables

- Pastor Troy O'Quin from River Oaks Community Church opened the meeting with prayer.
- The board approved the appointment of Village Treasurer Beth Herman to the Fire Pension Board and the Police Pension Board.
- In a housekeeping matter, the board approved a resolution authorizing the resumption of Tax Increment Finance (TIF) benefit payments to Extra Space Storage instead of to their lender.
- The board approved a four-year intergovernmental agreement with the Village of Lansing for the use of the Lansing courtroom.
- The board approved an ordinance that amends the fee schedule for the annual vehicle registration sticker, which includes moderate increases and stiffer penalties.
- The board approved an ordinance amending the zoning map for property located at 168th & South Park Avenue.
