### **School Crossing Guard Employment Opportunity**

The Village of South Holland, Illinois, is actively seeking candidates to fill **School Crossing Guard** positions with its South Holland Police Department.

The South Holland Police Department (SHPD) relies on School Crossing Guards to provide professional and effective customer service, support the mission of the SHPD by protecting the safety of children on their way to and from school.

The **School Crossing Guard** directs the child-pedestrian and proximate motor vehicle and other traffic to ensure school children safely cross streets and travel upon sidewalks during assigned times at assigned posts on school days.

Additional responsibilities of the **School Crossing Guard** include, but are not limited to:

- Ensuring children only cross streets, alleys and driveways when safe to do so.
- Stopping movements of motor vehicles and other traffic to ensure the safe and expedient movement of pedestrian and pedal-cycle school children.
- Surveying assigned posts for unsafe conditions or unusual events and communicates to appropriate officials regarding those conditions.
- Properly wearing assigned protective clothing and equipment while on duty.

#### **Requirements/Skills:**

- Minimum of 18 years of age, high school diploma or GED equivalent.
- Must be physically and mentally capable of performing duties in all types of weather.
- Must pass a background check to assure that applicant is free of any felony or misdemeanor convictions, including those of moral turpitude.
- Be able to transport self to assigned post(s) regardless of weather conditions.
- Complete and pass a Basic Adult School Crossing Guard course of instruction as prescribed by the South Holland Police Department.
